



BONNET GUARD FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY BEFORE INSTALLATION.





- 1. Clean and open bonnet.
- 2. Position the Bonnet Guard on the hood and note the 4 hole positions and remove the 4 plastic retaining clips
- 3. Insert the tabs of the Bonnet Guard between the rubber washer and the bonnet.
- 4. Fasten Bonnet Guard with 4 supplied push pin bases & plastic screws, first through the rubber washer, and then through the Bonnet Guard and into the hole in the bonnet.
- 5. Note: Hold the push-pin base when fixing Bonnet Guard to vehicle to ensure firmly tightened.
- 6. Stick the anti-abrasive tape on edge of hood where plastic fastening clip secures the Bonnet Guard near the fenders. Use the supplied alcohol preppads to cleanse the area first.
- 7. Snap plastic clip into hole position on Bonnet Guard as shown, over the antiabrasive tape.

Hood adjustment: After fitment of Bug Guard, it is important to check if there is sufficient room between the hood and the grille. Close hood slowly to determine if room is sufficient. If doubtful, it is advisable to adjust the hood stops to allow more room.

CLOSE THE HOOD BY DROPPING FROM 6" HEIGHT.
ASSIST CLOSURE ONLY BY PRESSING ON THE HOOD.
NEVER PRESS ON THE HOOD PROTECTOR.
